THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY CHARGES:

COUNT I:

That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about May 6, 2015, at or near Anchorage, JEFFREY ALLEN SKILLINGSTAD recklessly caused serious physical injury to another by means of a dangerous instrument.

All of which is a Felony class A offense being contrary to and in violation of 11.41.200(a)(1) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

COUNT II:

That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about May 6, 2015, at or near Anchorage, JEFFREY ALLEN SKILLINGSTAD recklessly placed another person in fear of imminent serious physical injury by means of a dangerous instrument.

All of which is a Felony class C offense being contrary to and in violation of 11.41.220(a)(1)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

COUNT III:

That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about May 6, 2015, at or near Anchorage, JEFFREY ALLEN SKILLINGSTAD discharged a firearm with reckless disregard for a risk of damage to property or a risk of physical injury to a person under circumstances other than those described in AS 11.61.195(a)(3)(A).

All of which is a Misdemeanor class A offense being contrary to and in violation of 11.61.210(a)(3) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

COUNT IV:

That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about May 6, 2015, at or near Anchorage, JEFFREY ALLEN SKILLINGSTAD recklessly engaged in conduct which created a substantial risk of serious physical injury to another person.

All of which is a Misdemeanor class A offense being contrary to and in violation of 11.41.250 and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

#### COUNT V:

That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about May 6, 2015, at or near Anchorage, JEFFREY ALLEN SKILLINGSTAD recklessly engaged in conduct which created a substantial risk of serious physical injury to another person.

All of which is a Misdemeanor class A offense being contrary to and in violation of 11.41.250 and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

The undersigned swears under oath this Information is based upon a review of police report 15-17871 submitted to date.

On May 6, 2015, David Miller and his son Ryan were managing a paint crew working on a job painting the Meadow Ridge Condos on Lunar Drive with a crew of approximately 10 men. That morning Johnnie Morgan and JEFFREY SKILLINGSTAD got into an argument over the equipment. During the argument, Morgan's brother Ronnie Morgan got involved and SKILLINGSTAD and Ronnie Morgan started calling each other names until SKILLINGSTAD walked away.

A short time later, SKILLINGSTAD walked up to Ronnie Morgan, pulled a gun, and said he was going to kill him. SKILLINGSTAD shot Ronnie Morgan once in the stomach and then shot again hitting him in the arm. Johnnie Morgan said he started to run with SKILLINGSTAD following him say he was going to kill him. Johnnie Morgan did not believe that SKILLINGSTAD shot at him, but he was afraid he was going to be killed.

Witnesses called 911 reporting the SKILLINGSTAD had left the area in white van. Officers were able to locate the van and took SKILLINGSTAD into custody. SKILLINGSTAD gave a mirandized statement and told officers that he had been arguing with the Morgan brothers. He admitted to going to his van to get his gun, returned and pointed the gun at Ronnie Morgan's head. He then changed his mind and shot him in the stomach instead. SKILLINGSTAD claimed that he could have killed him if he wanted, but he chased the brother instead in order to scare him. He told detectives he could have shot Johnnie Morgan in the back, but decided against it.
