THE OFFICE OF SPECIAL PROSECUTIONS AND APPEALS CHARGES:

That on or about July 18, 2013, at or near Palmer in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, GAYLE L. STANGER committed the crime of theft and the value of the property or services was \$50 or more.

All of which is a class A misdemeanor offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.46.140(a)(1) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Probable Cause Statement:

The undersigned swears under oath this Information is based upon a review of the Medicaid Fraud Control Unit (MFCU) investigative report submitted to date.

On July 25, 2013, Lianne Schwartz contacted Alaska State Troopers to report that medication had been stolen from her residence in Wasilla. Schwartz reported that Medicaid respite worker Gail Stanger stole the medication while caring for a Medicaid recipient staying in her residence. Schwartz reported that she became suspicious of Stanger after her husband's medications went missing. Schwartz set up a surveillance camera in her bedroom which captured photos of Stanger taking eight Percocet pills on July 18, 2013. Trooper Cronins contacted Stanger who admitted stealing the eight Percocet pills on July 18, 2013. A local pharmacy informed Trooper Cronins that the pills valued \$95.92.
